**GHANA, WEST AFRICA**

God bless you for praying for the Ghana trip. Team members were Pastors Jerry and Chip Foster, Jean Tiessen and myself, Janet MacArthur. We began ministering at the Liberian Refugee Camp outside of Accra, the capital city. Leroy Gibson, the Director of Shalom Victory Bible College was our host that arranged a pastors/leaders seminar and also seminar for Children's teachers. They both were wonderful. The pastors' seminar was packed. The Lord gave very timely messages on transition and intimacy. I did not know that by the end of the month, people on the camp had to make a decision because the camp was closing down and the UN was giving opportunity for many to go back to Liberia. It was a very timely message for them. God is caring for His people to send timely information, teaching, encouragement at such a time as this. Leroy Gibson is planning to go to Liberia next month and to start the process for establishing a Bible College there as well, with the idea of expanding it to several other areas and nations while maintaining the college in Ghana. I met with his Ghana Bible College Board and they represented, Liberia, Ghana and Sierra Leone. Three different West African nations in one school and all holders of degrees in their fields of studies. I was very impressed with their commitment and determination to see it through.

**CHILDREN'S TEACHERS SEMINAR**

The children's teachers' seminar was equally well attended with 60 people and Jean did a great job. The teachers loved it. We did preaching and teaching at a few other churches and revival meetings.

We were able to do a Children's Crusade, another pastor / leaders seminar to bring unity, networking and teamwork to one of the zones on the camp and other ministry in churches.

#### **FIRST NATIONS MINISTRY IN CANADA**

I leave in one week (Saturday, July 14) for Hart, Michigan to minister at Word of Life Church and from there to Canada for 2 mission trips. One team will be going to the Mohawk Nation in Deseronto, Ontario, (July 18-25) the next week will be a team trip to Oneida Nation near London, Ontario. (July 27-29) There is some tension right now in Canada due to land claims on the reservation lands. Please pray for God to intervene in this situation due to the possibility of sparks being set off. Pray for wisdom for the Canadian government and 1<sup>st</sup> Nation leaders. Also pray for our teams to have a great impact and that the fruit that remains from our visit there will be 100 fold.

The next few months are very busy for Good News for the Nations. Trips are scheduled for six different nations: Mohawk, Oneida, Mexico, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi (East Africa). There is so much work to schedule and communicate with all the team members, and the hosts in these nations. Please hold these trips up in prayer. Thank you so much!
