So many yet to help but limited due to finances. *"I was 9 yrs old when my father left. My mother was crippled & couldn't support us so we were hungry most of the time and suffered a lot. I found out my uncle was going to sacrifice me to his god. I was taken to Sharon Titian's. I had the baby & gave it for adoption, went to school & now I have Jesus & am very happy."*

China

CHINA MAY 2004

Last year during a time of prayer and fasting the Lord spoke to me about going to China very soon. I was waiting for a contact or an open door. In February of 2004 Dennis & Robin N. asked me to go with them to China to do a prayer seminar. Pastor *Joseph wanted us to teach the leadership of his church. We flew to China, checked into a hotel and prepared to teach the next morning.

*Joseph began his own church network last year and now has twenty-one people and two cell churches in operation. Robin & I taught his leaders. In China it is customary to take the children everywhere. One little boy, about four years old was very naughty and causing much distraction.

Encouraged to obey calling

*Tom, one of the leaders, was unusually quiet. We discovered that he was leaving that same day for India for one month to work for his company. He had \$1000 from his company and that morning on the bus someone had pick pocketed the money. He was devastated! His monthly salary is only \$200. By the end of the day the Lord had impressed upon Dennis to give him \$1000 out of his pocket. Dennis trusts the Lord to replace it. Tom was so grateful! I had shared about how the Lord prepared me to “live by faith” for a mission calling. He said the Lord was speaking to him to go into full time ministry and he was fearful and hesitant about it due to finances. Receiving \$1000 was a demonstration for him that God was able to provide in unexpected ways!

Prophetic Word fulfilled

Several days before we left for China, we received a prophetic word. The Lord spoke that we would lay hands on people and they would be healed, filled with the Holy Spirit and children would be touched by Him.

God's Word fulfilled

At the end of the first day of teaching we prayed for people. Some received the baptism of the Holy Spirit, some were healed and some were delivered from demons. We prayed for the little boy that was so naughty and demons manifested. Before we finished, he was delivered of demons of anger, disobedience, and rebellion. Immediately his countenance changed! He was peaceful and full of the joy of the Holy Spirit. We prayed for a young boy and girl. They received healing and both received the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Robin and I taught 2 days and Joseph extended the seminar to 3 days because of how the Lord was moving in our midst.

. By the end we were close to all the leaders. Wonderful spirit-led times of ministry followed each day of teaching. One young college age man was invited by his aunt and received Jesus as Savior. He was so excited that he invited four of his friends from college to come to Joseph's church on Sunday. Eight people were led to the Lord this week by those attending our seminar. They were so filled with the Holy Spirit that they were enthusiastically witnessing about Jesus. Joseph was so excited! He said this was the best seminar ever.

It was great to have that time to relax as I had just returned from Ghana the week before this trip. Ghana was hot and more difficult physically.
